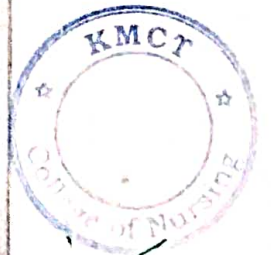

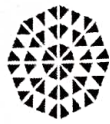

* On 16/11/2019 the 4th year (5th batch) result was announced and the pass percentage was 96.6%.

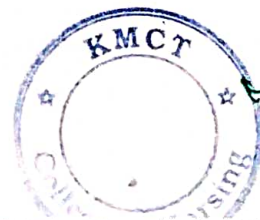
* On 20/11/2019, Freshers day (2019-2023 batch) was conducted by the 2nd year students.
