Book Bank Policy

Introduction

Kmct college of nursing(kmct con) provides a Book Bank facility to support economically disadvantaged but meritorious students. The aim of this service is to ensure that all students have access to the necessary academic resources to excel in their studies.

Eligibility Criteria

The Book Bank facility is available to students belonging to the Economically Weaker Section (EWS). Eligible students are selected based on the details provided during the admission process.

Allocation of Books

- The allocation of books is subject to the availability of sets.
- Priority is given to students based on their merit in the last examination.

Responsibilities of Students

- Students availing the Book Bank facility must return the entire set of books provided to them within two days of completing their final examination in the concerned semester/term.
- If a student loses, damages, or disfigures a book, they must replace the volume(s) with new books or pay the current cost of the book plus any applicable fines as directed by the authority.
